Covering conditions Stud St. Stephan, Framersheim

All mare owners, who want to make use of our listed stallions, have to accept the following terms and conditions for current and future business relations.

- 1. Breeding season starts 1st of March and finishes 31st of July. Terms and conditions of the respective breeding association apply.
- 2. Our stallions are available with fresh semen. If a stallion is unavailable during the breeding season at a short notice due to special reasons (overstrain, show, stallion performance test, illness ect.), you can, if possible, refer to a later estrus or if you wish you can use a different stallion of our station.
- 3. **Semen order**: we request your semen order from Monday to Friday before 10 am, Saturdays before 9 am for shipping same day within Germany. Together with the semen order there has to be on hand: a copy of the pedigree as proof of descent or breeding certificate, the swab result as well as the exact invoice- and dispatch address and a proof of the qualification as inseminator for the own horses (proof of qualification as duplicate or electronic form). The original breeding certificate has to be submitted immediately.
- 4. About the insemination a breeding certificate is issued in the end of the breeding season. The delivery of the breeding certificate as well as the association's notification can only be made if the stud fee invoice has been paid.
- 5. Liability: the stud is not liable for damage, illness or injury of humans or animals as well as for means of transport or others, only in case of resolution and coarse negligence. To cover the risk in liability as legal livestock owner (§§833, 834, BGB) the mare owner has to complete a liability insurance.
- 6. **Dispatch of semen**: The costs and risks are at the expense of the breeder. The transport risk of the semen passes to the mare owner upon collection or dispatch from the station. The St. Stephan Stud does not guarantee the timely delivery of semen to the breeder or to the contracted veterinarian if the semen has been properly handed over to the shipping company. The semen containers are to be immediately returned after insemination with fully completed dispatch documents.

For the dispatch to a foreign country: The shipping costs are at the expenses of the mare owner. The stud owner, in the case of dispatch to a foreign country, is obliged to apply for a veterinarian certificate. The costs of administration charge are to be paid by the mare owner, too.

7. The place of contractual fulfillment and court of jurisdiction is the residence of the stud owner.
